## RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NUMBER 96-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING / DENYING THE REQUEST FOR VARIANCE.

WHEREAS, WAYNE E. CASEY filed an application for VARIANCE FROM THE REQUIRED LOCAL STREET SETBACK FROM 15 FEET TO 8 FEET 6 INCHES; and,

WHEREAS, the subject property is located at 5700 ESTERO BLVD., Ft. Myers Beach, and is described more particularly as in Section 33, Township 46 South, Range 24 East, Lee County, Florida; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant has indicated the property's current STRAP number is: 33-46-24-W2-0030B.0010; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was advertised and held on October 21, 1996, before the Fort Myers Beach Town Council who gave full and complete consideration to the recommendations of the staff and the Local Planning Agency, the documents on file with Lee County, and the testimony of all interested persons; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FORT MYERS BEACH TOWN COUNCIL, that the Council APPROVES / DENIES the request.

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

The following findings and conclusions were made in conjunction with the approval / denial of the requested modification:

- Section 1. That there are / are not exceptional or extraordinary conditions or circumstances that are inherent to the property in question and that do not apply generally to the other nearby properties in the same zoning district.
- Section 2. That the exceptional or extraordinary conditions or circumstances are/ are not the result of actions of the applicant taken subsequent to the adoption of the ordinance (any action taken by an applicant pursuant to lawfully adopted regulations preceding the adoption of the ordinance from which this chapter is derived will not be considered self-created);
- Section 3. That the variance is / is not the minimum variance that will relieve the applicant of an unreasonable burden caused by the application of the regulation in question to his property.

Section 4. That the granting of the variance  $\frac{\text{will }}{\text{mill not}}$  be injurious to the neighborhood or otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

Section 5. That the condition or situation of the specific piece of property, or the intended use of the property, for which the variance is sought is / is not of so general or recurrent nature as to make it more reasonable and practical to amend the ordinance.
