## RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NUMBER 99-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE AREA 1000 FEET SEAWARD OF LITTLE ESTERO ISLAND AREA AS AN IDLE SPEED ZONE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach, incorporated under Chapter 95-494, Laws of Florida, and has subsequently adopted Ordinance Number 96-26, the "Town of Fort Myers Beach Vessel Control and Water Safety Ordinance"; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council has complied with the terms of that ordinance and determined that the designation is necessary for the safety and/or welfare of the citizens of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Town Designation. The Town Council of the Town of Fort

Myers Beach hereby designates the area 1000 feet seaward of Little Estero

Island as an idle speed zone.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council and after the Town Manager shall publish the Resolution one time in a newspaper of general circulation in Lee County, Florida, after which the designation of the area shall be complete and binding; provided, however, no person shall be convicted of a violation of this resolution relating to such specified area until

signs designating the boundaries of the area so designated have been posted in such a manner and place that they may reasonably be expected to be seen and read by a person operating a vessel in that area.
