RESOLUTION NUMBER 99- 22

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH,  
FLORIDA, PROVIDING TEST CLOSING AND SETTING A  
HEARING TO CONSIDER CLOSING THE LEFT TURN FROM  
ESTERO BOULEVARD AT TIMES SQUARE; PROVIDING TEST  
CLOSING; PUBLIC HEARING; DESCRIPTION OF REGULATED  
ROAD; PROPOSED RESTRICTIONS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach has the governmental, corporate, and proprietary "Home Rule Powers" pursuant to Article VIII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Florida and Chapter 166 of the Florida Statutes to enable it to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal services, and may exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Town Council consider restriction of motor vehicle traffic on that portion of a public road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Test Closing of Left Turn. During the months of September, October and November of 1999, the left turn opening from Estero Boulevard to Times Square will be closed and obstructed to prohibit left turns except for emergency vehicles.

Section 2. Public Hearing. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby sets 6:30 P.M. on November 15<sup>th</sup>, 1999, as the time and date of a public hearing to consider restrictions on motor vehicle traffic making a left turn from Estero Boulevard at Times Square.

Section 2. Description of Regulated Road. That portion of Estero Boulevard that connects to the bridge to San Carlos Boulevard.

Section 3. Proposed Restrictions. Total prohibition of left turns by motor vehicle traffic from Estero Boulevard to Times Square.

Section 4. Publication. The Town Manager shall cause this resolution to be published one time at least one week before the public hearing and for a copy of this resolution to be delivered to all property owners abutting the restricted road.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council.


The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


