2. **July 4<sup>th</sup> – Parade** will leave Bay Oaks at 10:00 am and travel northwest on Estero Blvd. Come Out and Show Your American Spirit!
3. **July 4<sup>th</sup> – Times Square Activities – 1pm-3pm near the Clock.** Bay Oaks Recreation Staff will be hosting patriotic crafts, watermelon eating contest and American themed trivia. Come test your skills or cheer on your neighbor.
4. **July 4<sup>th</sup> – Newton Beach Park 9 am Beach Walk Mound House - 10 am Cool Calusa Indian Tools – 11 am Guided Tours – 1 pm Calusa Indian Shell Mound Tour – 2 pm Family Adventures** - Come enjoy the beautiful property and activities. 6. **EMERGENCY PREPARATIONS – CODE RED** - The Town of Fort Myers Beach uses the CODE RED notification system to warn residents, business owners, and property owners of emergencies, like hurricane evacuations or boil water notices. To sign up Click on the Code Red button found on the Town's website.
7. **TOWN DRINKING WATER** Beach Water is pleased to present a summary of the quality of the drinking water provided to you during 2016. You may find the current report on the Beach Water Department page.
8. **SHORT TERM RENTALS - Quiet hours:** Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., all guests shall observe quiet hours. This means all outdoor activity, including swimming, shall be kept to a reasonable noise level that is non-intrusive and respectful of neighbors. Town of Fort Myers Beach Ordinance No. 96-24 sets limits on noise levels during quiet hours and these levels must be obeyed by all guests.
9. **BUDGET** – Council budget discussions will occur in August and Formal hearings for budget will be held on September 7 and September 21 at 6:30 p.m. If you would like more information or have questions, contact Maureen Rischitelli at 239-765-0202 ext. 1200.
10. **WATER & STORMWATER PROJECT** – Work is continuing on the Estero Blvd and Town side streets; including the construction of joint outfalls.
