## Town of Fort Myers Beach Top Ten for October

- **HURRICANE CLEANUP – As of today, November 1<sup>st</sup>:**
  - The Town has completed all horticultural pick up on Town roads (North Estero and Side Streets.) Lee County has completed collection of all horticultural debris from Estero Boulevard from Times Square, south to Big Carlos Pass Bridge. The Town is concluding the collection of horticultural from private roads and has begun collection of construction debris as of October 31, 2017.
  - Advance Disposal has resumed their "normal waste collection services including horticultural that adheres to their standard rules for collection. For details: <https://www.leegov.com/solidwaste/post-hurricane-debris-action-guidelines>"

- **PERMITS & PLANS – EPLAN IS NOW AVAILABLE** – Community Development has implemented Eplan, a web based application, which allows you to electronically submit your permits online and download the approved plans from your computer.
