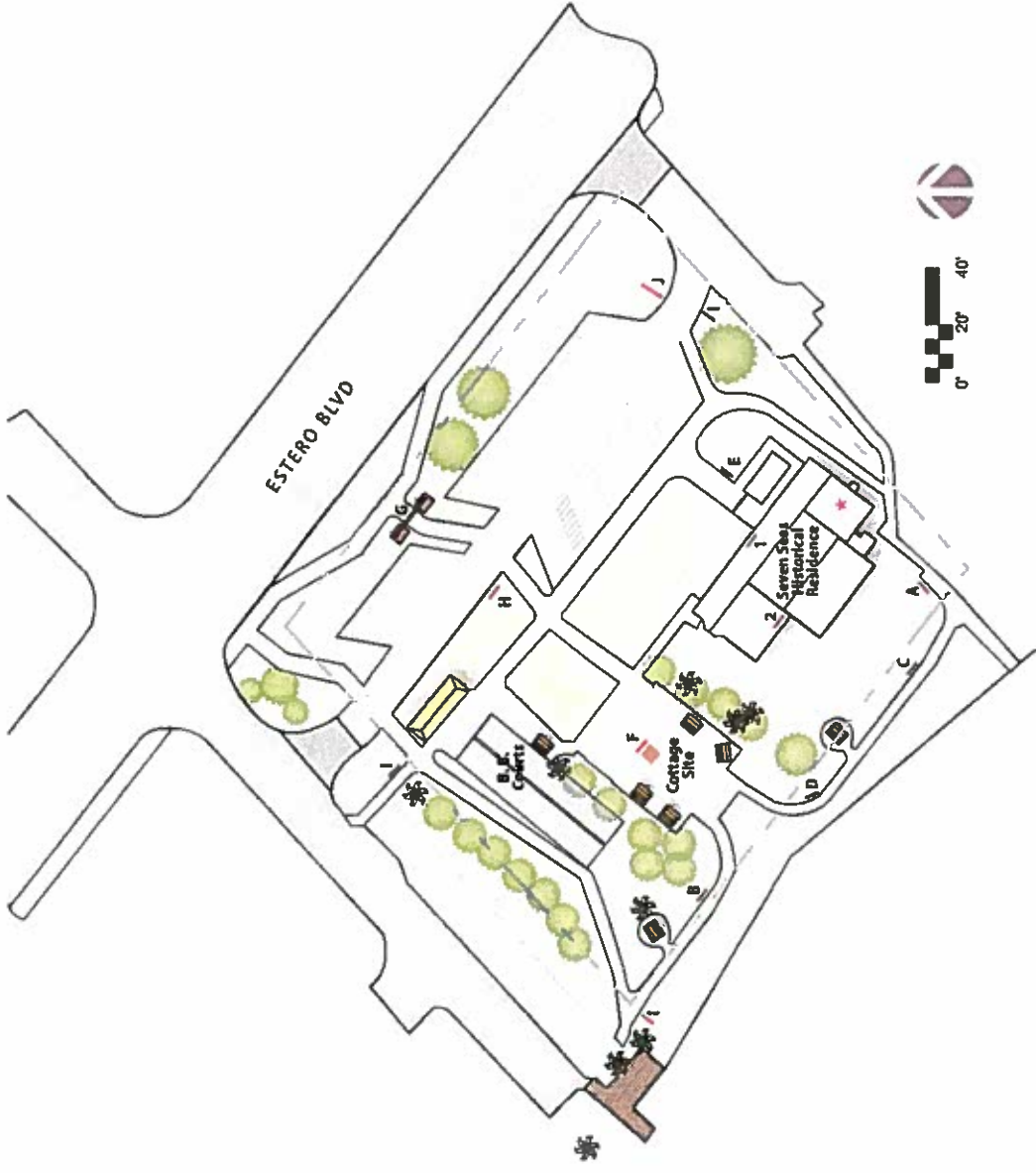

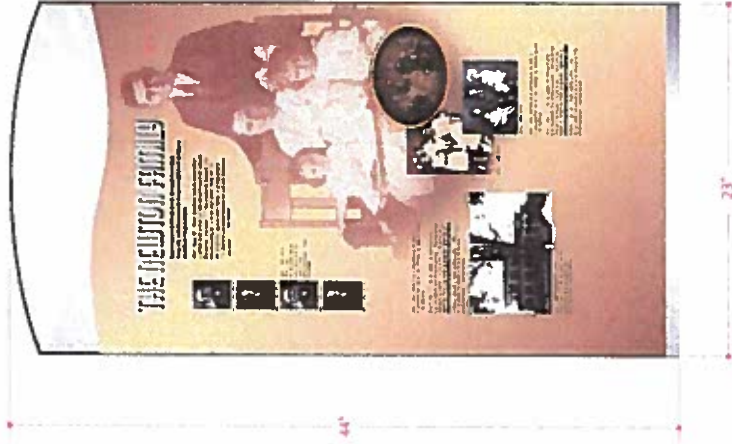

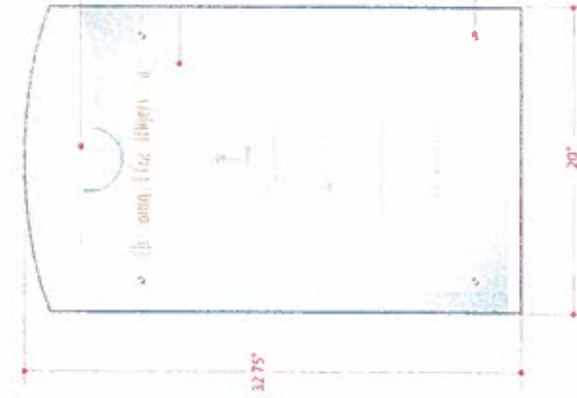


Newton Interpretive Panel

A profile cut panel of Digital Diamond on a 1/2" backer with painted edges or a 3/4" thick, 12-color, phenolic graphic by Fossil. All graphics composite in print.

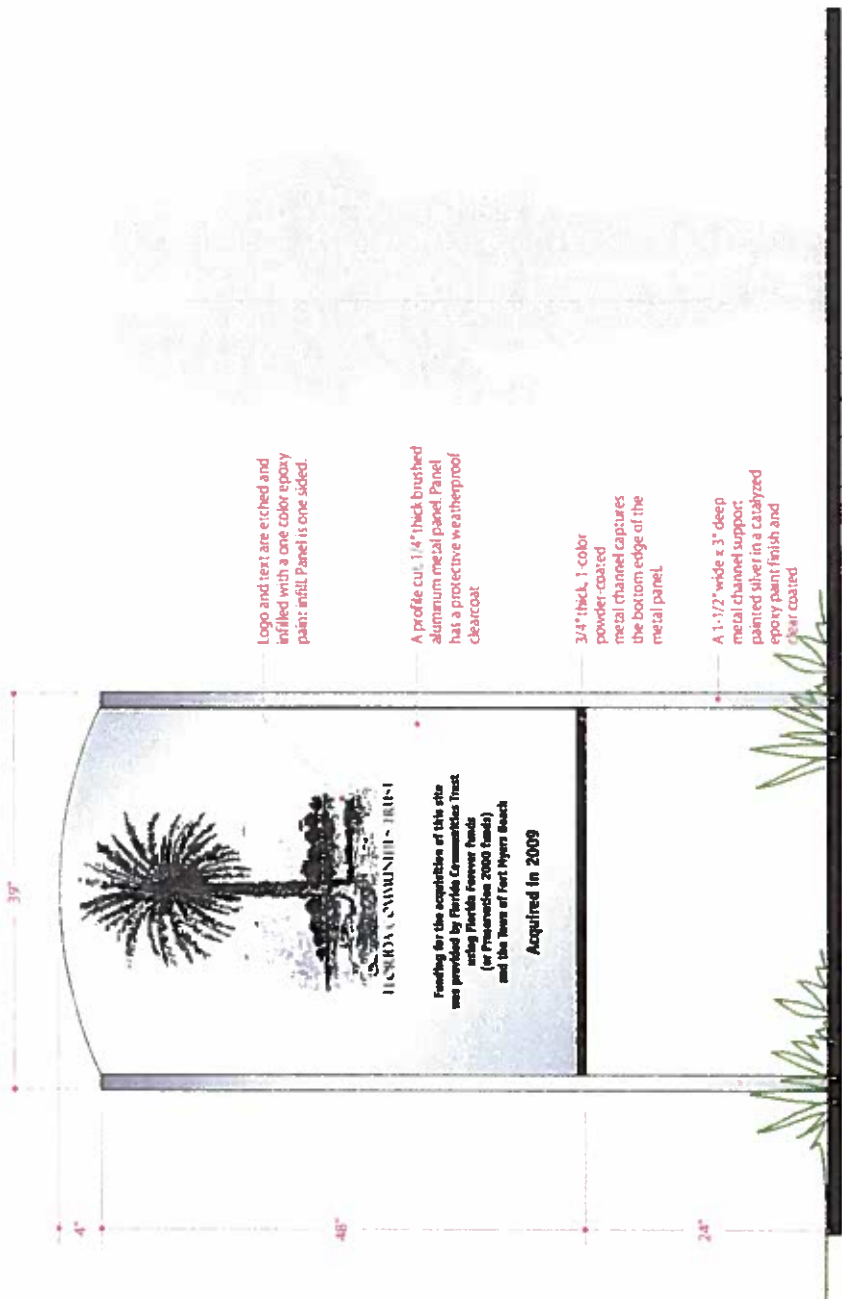
Sponsor Panel

Historical Newton ship silhouette

A profiled piece of 3/8" thick laminated safety glass with a second surface etch to a depth of 1/32". Infill etched areas with an epoxy paint (gold or white) to fill voids & assure legibility.

A 1 1/2" diameter brushed aluminum puck holds the panel in place. The safety glass is drilled in all four corners of the panel.



Logo and text are etched and filled with a one color epoxy paint. Panel is one-sided.

A profile cut, 1/4" thick brushed aluminum metal panel. Panel has a protective weatherproof clearcoat.

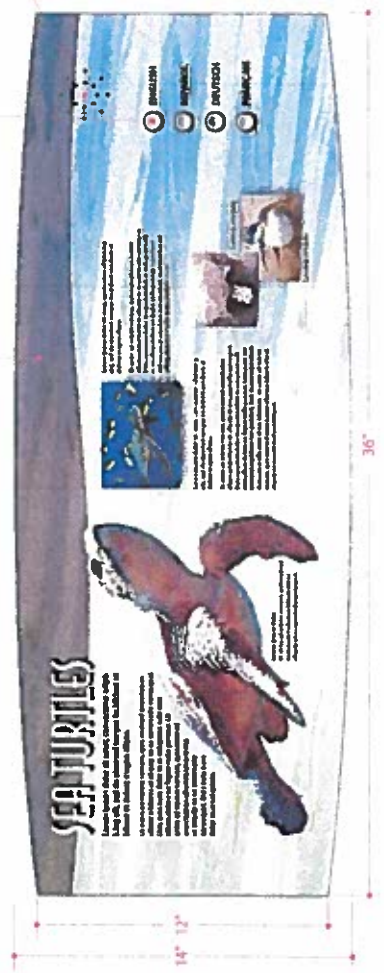
3/4" thick, 1 color powder-coated metal channel captures the bottom edge of the metal panel.

A 1-1/2" wide x 3" deep metal channel support painted silver in a catalyzed epoxy paint finish and powder coated.

Bulgin low-profile stainless-steel audio buttons (4 languages - 1 minute max per language)

Drill holes for speaker to angle down to front surface of panel

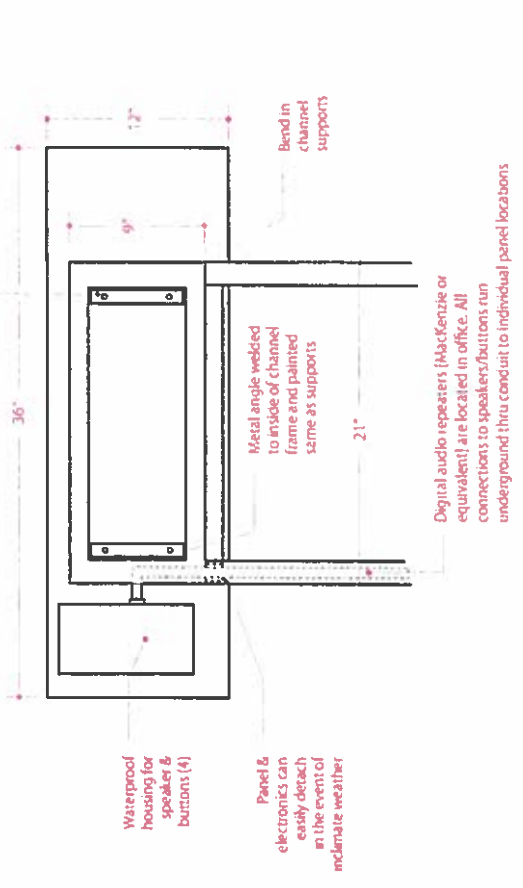
Please Note: Fabricator is responsible for running the conduit for the exterior signage at Newton Park. At Mound House the conduit system will be existing at time of install.

Waterproof housing for speaker & buttons (4)

Panel & electronics can easily detach in the event of inclement weather

Mechanically fasten panel to interior side of aluminum channel w/ stainless-steel security screws

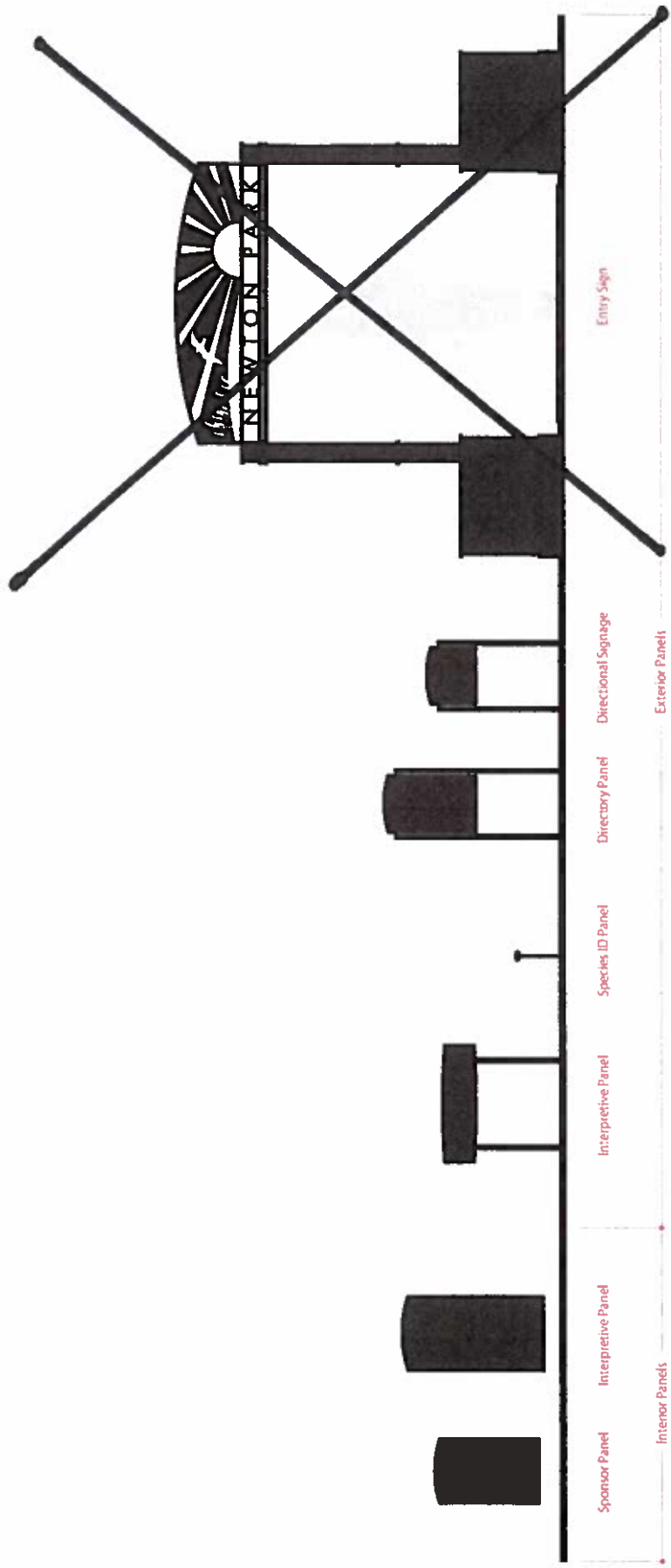
Concrete footer

Anchor bolt

All holes for signs for archaeological mitigation

1 1/2" PVC conduit stub affixed to panel support leg for wiring to speaker and buttons on panel

Entire leg should be painted and clear coated

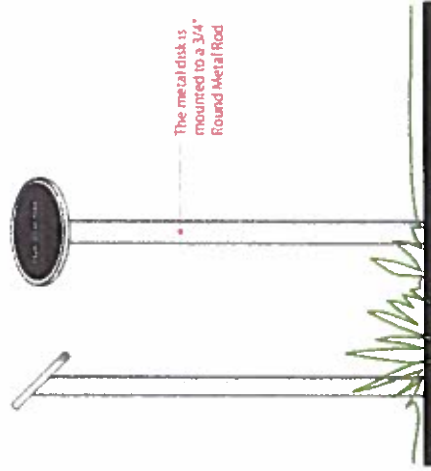

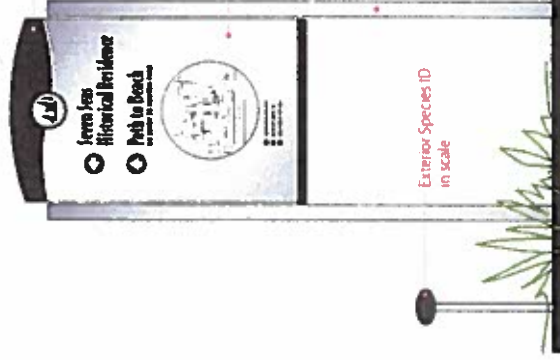
